There are 1000 students at the Newcastle Campus, and with campuses at Port Stephens, Gosford and Cessnock, the total enrolment is 2700. St Philip's also has 2 pre-schools, a school for teenage mothers and an alternative school for students who would be at risk of not completing basic Year 10 leaving requirements (NSW School Certificate). Each main campus has a Junior, Middle and Senior School structure. There are 350 students in the Middle School at the Newcastle Campus. The Newcastle campus has an optional laptop program commencing for students in Year 7; approx 70% of students take this opportunity.</p>
